



LRQA Independent Assurance Statement

Relating to Travis Perkins plc's specific selected environmental datasets in the Annual Report for 2025

This Assurance Statement has been prepared for Travis Perkins plc in accordance with our contract.

Terms of Engagement

LRQA was commissioned by Travis Perkins plc (Travis Perkins) to provide independent assurance of specific selected environmental datasets ("the datasets") disclosed in the Annual Report for the calendar year 2025 to a limited assurance and materiality of the professional judgement of the verifier using LRQA's verification procedure. LRQA's verification procedure is based on current best practise and is in accordance with ISAE 3000 and ISAE 3410.

Our assurance engagement covered Travis Perkins' operations and activities where they have a controlling share (i.e. $\geq 51\%$ equity) and operational control and specifically the following specific selected datasets:

- Carbon emissions – Scope 1 [from combustion of natural gas and fuels, and from refrigerant losses]
- Carbon emissions – Scope 2 [from use of purchased electricity]
- Carbon emissions – Scope 3 [Categories 1, 4, 9 and 11 (representing $>95\%$ of Scope 3 emissions)]
- Timber – percentage of material purchased from certified sources
- Waste – tonnage produced [recovered vs landfill]
- Environmental incidents reported

Our assurance engagement excluded the data and information of Travis Perkins' suppliers, contractors and any third-parties used to calculate the datasets.

LRQA's responsibility is only to Travis Perkins. LRQA disclaims any liability or responsibility to others as explained in the end footnote. Travis Perkins' responsibility is for collecting, aggregating, analysing and presenting all the data and information within the datasets and for maintaining effective internal controls over the systems from which the datasets are derived. Ultimately, the datasets have been approved by, and remain the responsibility of Travis Perkins.

LRQA's Opinion

Based on LRQA's approach nothing has come to our attention that would cause us to believe that Travis Perkins has not, in all material respects:

- Met the requirements of the criteria listed above; and
- Disclosed accurate and reliable performance data and information as summarized in Table 1 below.

The opinion expressed is formed on the basis of a limited level of assurance¹ and at the materiality of the professional judgement of the verifier.

¹ The extent of evidence-gathering for a limited assurance engagement is less than for a reasonable assurance engagement. Limited assurance engagements focus on aggregated data rather than physically checking source data at sites. Consequently, the level of assurance obtained in a limited assurance engagement is lower than the assurance that would have been obtained had a reasonable assurance engagement been performed.

LRQA’s Approach

LRQA’s assurance engagements are carried out in accordance with our verification procedure. The following tasks were undertaken as part of the evidence gathering process for this assurance engagement:

- Auditing remotely Travis Perkins’s data management systems, to confirm that there were no significant errors, omissions or mis-statements in the datasets. We did this by:
 - reviewing the data reporting and internal assurance processes.
 - speaking with key people involved in collating the aggregated data.
 - checking aggregated data in the spreadsheets for unintentional transcription / accounting mistakes made when entering records.
- LRQA did not verify the specified selected datasets back to original sources, nor did it assess the accuracy and completeness of the data reported by individual locations or third-party suppliers. Travis Perkins has used the best available sales data at the time the report was produced for the normalisation of the carbon and waste data.

Observations

Further observations and findings, made during the assurance engagement, are:

- Although data management systems are mature, granularity was improved in both Scope 1 and 2 figures with further information now available for electricity consumption through landlords, and greater visibility of all oil and fuel transaction details.



LRQA's Standards, Competence and Independence

LRQA implements and maintains a comprehensive management system that meets accreditation requirements for ISO 14065 *Greenhouse gases – Requirements for greenhouse gas validation and verification bodies for use in accreditation or other forms of recognition* and ISO/IEC 17021 *Conformity audit – Requirements for bodies providing audit and certification of management systems* that are at least as demanding as the requirements of the International Standard on Quality Control 1 and comply with the *Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants* issued by the International Ethics Standards Board for Accountants.

LRQA ensures the selection of appropriately qualified individuals based on their qualifications, training and experience. The outcome of all verification and certification audits is then internally reviewed by senior management to ensure that the approach applied is rigorous and transparent.

LRQA is Travis Perkins' certification body for ISO14001. The verification and certification audits, together with the training, are the only work undertaken by LRQA for Travis Perkins and as such does not compromise our independence or impartiality.
